W7-15 - Privacy Policy

1. Purpose

This Policy sets out the manner in which Web7 handles personal information submitted by or collected from you whilst visiting the Web Africa website(s).

2. Definitions

- 2.1. "personal information" is as defined in the Promotion of Access to Information Act No 2 of 2000 ("PAIA")
- 2.2. "user" means any person accessing any part of the web site

3. Status

This Privacy Policy forms part of the Terms and Conditions of Use of this website and our services. Continued use of this website means you agree to the provisions of this Policy and are bound by them.

4. Collection of personal data

- 4.1. We collect only what is necessary and use it only for the purpose for which it is required.
- 4.2. We will neither sell your personal information to anyone nor otherwise dispose of it to a third party otherwise than as set out in the Policy. We will not attempt to obtain your permission to do so by deceptive means.
- 4.3. If we do not need it anymore, we will delete any personal information held.
- 4.4. We neither store nor retain any credit card information.
- 4.5. Web7 may request further personal information from the client to provide the required service. The information must be supplied in writing, by the client, according to Web7 specifications e.g. Debit order authority form.

5. Email communications

- 6.3. The date and time when the website is accessed, for the purpose of traffic and statistical monitoring.
